- 3. Each Candidate for Election must be nominated in writing and the nomination paper must be sent to the Chief Executive, so that it shall be received at 91 Bridgegate, Howden, Goole, DN14 7JJ not later than 5pm on Tuesday, 23rd of November 2021.
- 4. An Elector may not sign more Nomination Papers than there are Members to be elected for the Cowick & Snaith Internal Drainage Board.
- 5. Forms of Nomination Paper may be obtained free of charge from the Chief Executive at 91 Bridgegate, Howden, Goole, DN14 7JJ.
