

VACANCY – Full Time Apprentice Mechanic

Yorkshire and Humber Drainage Boards represent 8 flood risk management authorities. Our work reduces flood risk to thousands of residents, businesses, property, and infrastructure. We operate 83 pumping stations, maintain over 800 miles of watercourses and rivers that drain over 360 square miles of the region.

As a local public authority, we are keen to support the development of future technical specialists working in our industry. The successful applicant will complete Level 2 Land Based Service Engineering Apprenticeship, assisting, and learning from our Mechanical Engineer, an experienced agricultural engineer. Duties will include maintaining tractors, self-propelled agricultural machinery and other plant and equipment used for the maintenance of our watercourse networks. Although predominantly working in a modern well-equipped workshop there will be regular site visits, accompanying the mechanic to carry out repairs across the operational area.

Although this apprenticeship has a mechanical engineering bias, there will be opportunities to work in other service areas within the wider organisation, including project management, asset management, development control, finance, and democratic services.

After successful completion of the Level 2 qualification there may be an opportunity to progress to a relevant Level 3 qualification within our organisation.

The successful candidate will be motivated and inquisitive with a desire to join a team that operates some of the most important infrastructure in the region.

The role comes with a remuneration of £15,392 to £24,454.04 (national minimum wage requirements dependent on age), generous leave and automatic enrolment into the Local Government Pension scheme. The employer is Ouse and Humber Drainage Board, and you will normally be based at our headquarters in Newport, Brough, East Yorkshire.
